- Giving reality to “we the peoples.”



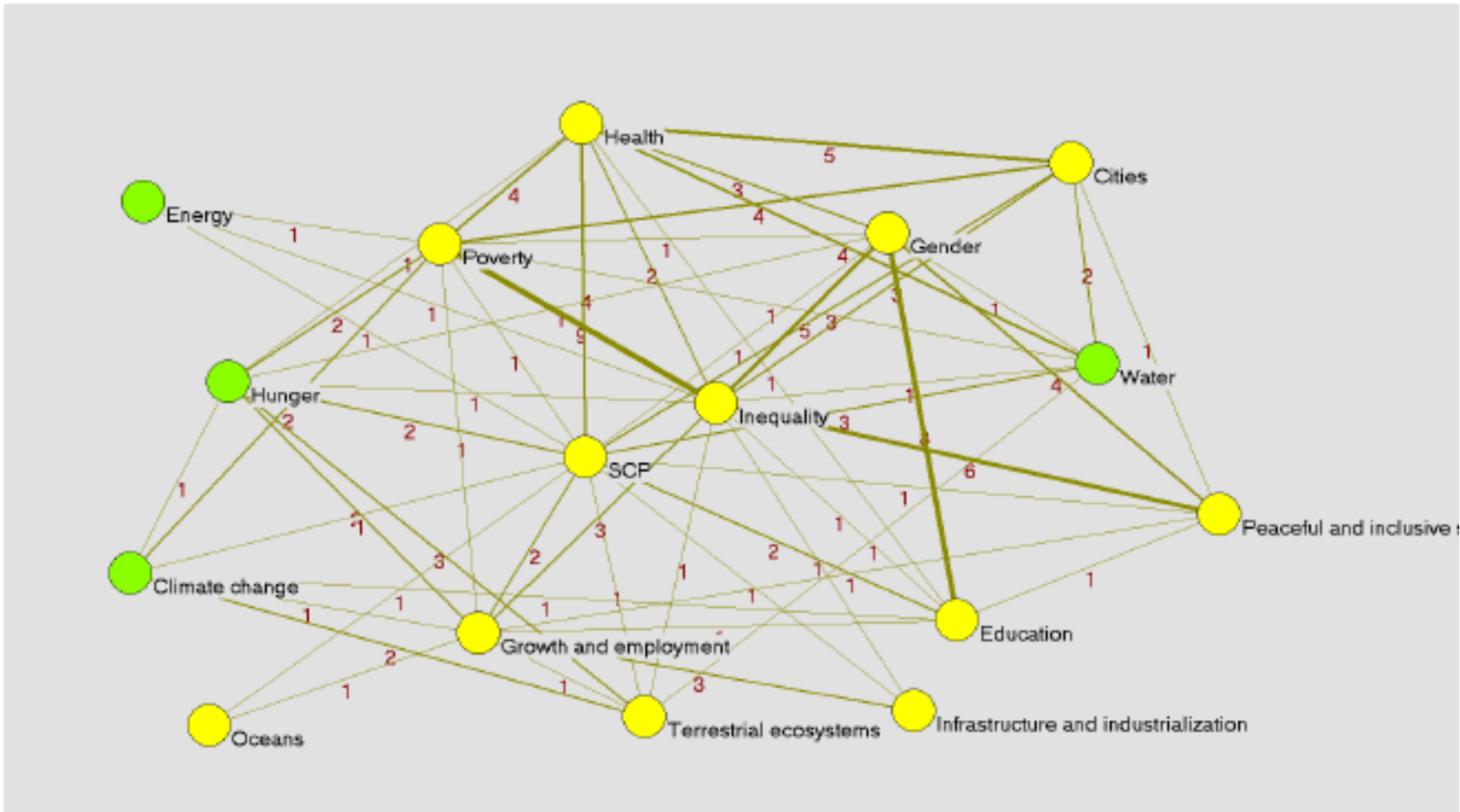
- SDGs highlight a clear development disconnect despite progress under MDGs

## 2. Implications for the Rest of Us



- How to translate the 6 SDGs pillars?
  - Example: how to translate the Universality Agenda?
- Horizontal and vertical integration
  - The need for leadership and coordinating skills at the top level
- Education and skills development
  - The need for sustainability skills, not only hard and soft skills



- You can rely on the public/people in the street
  - They want the big picture and the jobs get done
- Stakeholders participation and involvement
  - Peer reviews scheme for SDGs adaptation.
    - Officials advising officials do not work for SDGs





- Have to bring all stakeholders: parliamentarians, private sector, CSOs, Academics, and community at large → it's about bringing people together
- Do it differently: with peers from around the world
