Sustainable upland production landscape

- Sustainable agriculture plays a central role in achieving SDG 6 on water, SDG 12 on sustainable consumption and production, SDG 13 on climate change adaptation and mitigation, and SDG 15 on land use and ecosystems, SDG 1 on zero poverty, SDG 2 on no hunger, and SDG 8 on growth and decent job.
- There is a growing thought on the 'production landscape approach' for sustainable agriculture
- Production landscape is a landscape system focusing on food growing for both own consumption and income generation purposes. In many developing countries where a production landscape is a continuous part of the landscape systems, transitioning from forest to non-forested lands, the production landscape is multifunctional and provides different goods and services to various stakeholders.
- When managed sustainably, the production landscape has benefits on and beyond the farm.
